Life Jacket Trade-in Event

California State Parks Division of Boating and Waterways (DBW) partners for life jacket trade-in events each year. Life jacket trade-ins provide recreational boaters the opportunity to have life jackets inspected by safety professionals. If a life jacket is found to be unserviceable or the wearer has outgrown the life jacket, a new, properly fitted U.S. Coast Guard-approved life jacket will be given in exchange. One life jacket per person, while supplies last.

VESSEL SAFETY CHECK: The U.S. Coast Guard Auxiliary FL 07-61 will have certified vessel examiners who will perform a free Vessel Safety Check ("VSC") on your boat at the wash out stations or in the parking lot. There is no charge and you will know that you have all the proper safety equipment for your personal pleasure craft.
