Open Session included 12 consent items and 3 Discussion items, the discussion items were as follows:

- Harbor Patrol Staffing: Consideration of Temporary Augmentation of Staff Level; approved.
- Water Taxi Hours: Consider request from San Luis Yacht Club for added hours; continued.
- 2018/19 Appropriation Limit: Approve Limit; Resolution 18-14 adopted.

FAQ's – How Long Can I Camp with my RV on District Property (Nobi Point, Woodyard, Coastal Gateway, Babe Land and Overflow)? The Harbor District welcomes self-contained RV's to camp up to a maximum of 14 days. The one exception is in the Coastal Gateway area, spaces 1-14 which are reserved for those with a licensed vessel and the stay in spaces 1-14 is 3 days. 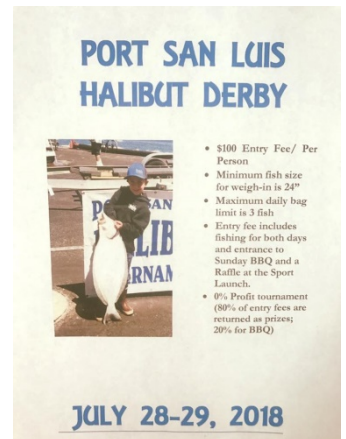

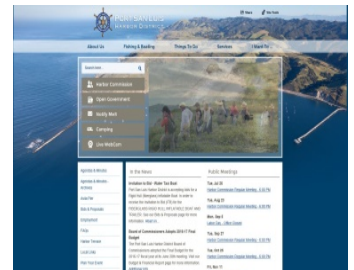
