- **RV Camping is by online RESERVATION ONLY.** Go to www.portsanluis.com RV Camping to make a reservation.
 - There is a 14-day maximum stay limit. Reservations made for longer than 14 days, those additional days will be cancelled, and a refund will not be issued.
- **Trailer Boat Camping:** are ALWAYS for trailer boat/recreational vessel use ONLY. You **MUST** have a registered vessel with you for use during your stay. No Exceptions. - You must have a reservation prior to pulling into an RV camping site.
- **Reservations must be made in the name of the individual that will be staying in the reserved camp site.** (See – *Third Party Vendors – Personal Use Section of the RV Camping Information & Rules & Regulations [below]*)
- **IMPORTANT - Fully self-contained units ONLY with installed & operable black & grey water hold tanks**
 - **NO portable, cassette or composting toilets or other removable sewer systems/tanks allowed**
 - **NO tent camping**
 - **Violation of this rule will result in a canceled reservation and a refund will not be issued.**
- **Camping Rates.** \$85 per night for hook-ups; \$65 per night for dry camping. \$10 reservation fee, per reservation
- Reservation Cancellations/Modifications: **Only two cancellations or modifications are allowed per calendar year.** Therefore, it is recommended reservations be made in each camper's own name and email address when making multiple reservations for the same time frame for friends and family.

 - **Cancellation Policy – Cancellation Policy will be followed & fees will still apply for ALL CANCELLATIONS**
 - **All cancellation and/or modification requests will incur a \$15 fee per transaction**
 - **72 hours prior to reservation start date: Full Refund, minus \$10 reservation fee and \$15 cancellation fee**
 - **48 hours prior to reservation start date: 50% Refund, minus \$10 reservation fee and \$15 cancellation fee**
 - **Less than 48 hours prior to reservation start date: No Refund**
 - **Prior to reservation start date = In advance of stay. Stay begins on the first day of reservation.**
- Check-in/Check-out information:
 - Check-in **2 pm**; Check-out: **Noon** (subject to Citation). **Early check-ins are not permitted.**
 - Trailer Boat Camping Area: Check-in: **5 pm**; Check-out: **Noon.** **Early check-ins are not permitted.**
 - You will be checked-in at your site by your **RV or Trailer license number** provided at time of reservation.
- Only RV/Trailer and ONE additional vehicle are allowed per space AND Do not park, encroach or overhang onto asphalt road right-of-way or neighboring camp sites.
- Leakage or discharge of ANY fluids strictly prohibited. No washing of RV or vehicles.
- No RV parking or camping in parking lot – RVs in parking lot after 10:00 PM are subject to citation.
- **Quiet Time Hours: 10:00 PM to 7:00 AM – THIS INCLUDES GENERATORS**
- **No open fires** – no barbecues, campfires, grills, heating or cooking devices, **other than those which are contained within your campsite AND are fueled by propane or gas with active on/off controls**, are permitted in any camping area.
- Dogs must be on a leash or in a contained area; must clean-up after dog.
- Dump Station - \$23 by appointment from 9:00 am to 10:30 am, AS AVAILABLE. Contact Camp Host to schedule appointment.
- **Campsites must be occupied a minimum of one hour every 24 hours (subject to citation).**
- **Violation of regulations may result in Citation and/or Eviction.**
- Third Party Vendors:
 - **Reservations are for personal use only.** Any resale, transfer, use, use for profit activity, or gifting of reservations/camp sites that are not approved in advance by the Port San Luis Harbor District are strictly prohibited and will be subject to immediate cancellation without notice, refund, or reimbursement. You may also not be allowed to make any new reservations or open new accounts.
 - No other outside vendor delivery, set-ups of RV's, Camping Trailers, BBQ's, tables, chairs, etc., are allowed and is subject to citation and cancellation of the reservations.
- Abuse of the Reservation System will result in a ban of use.

Trailer Boat Camping Requirements

Requirements

1. Boat/Recreational Vessel must be currently registered and displaying a vessel registration number.
2. Boat/Recreational Vessel must be on a trailer and towed by a current, registered vehicle.
3. Boat/Recreational Vessel must be on its own designated boat trailer and can only occupy one Trailer Boat Camping spot.
4. Check-in for Trailer Boat Camping: 5 pm
5. Check-out for Trailer Boat Camping: Noon
6. Port San Luis Launch Facility Receipts may be required and are to be provided when requested by a representative of the Port San Luis Harbor District.

Definitions

1. **Boat/Recreational Vessel:** a powered boat or other vessel that travels on water and is mechanically propelled.
2. **Mechanically Propelled:** Gas, diesel, or electric propulsion.
3. **Vessel Registration Number:** State issued Certificate of Number.
4. **Display of Numbers:** Numbers must be painted or permanently attached to each side of the forward half of the vessel.
5. **Boat/Recreational Vessel Trailer:** A boat/recreational trailer as identified by the California Vehicle Section Code 468 that is registered under the California Department of Motor Vehicles Permanent Trailer Identification (PTI) program or if out of state, similarly, follows the California Vehicle Section Code 468.

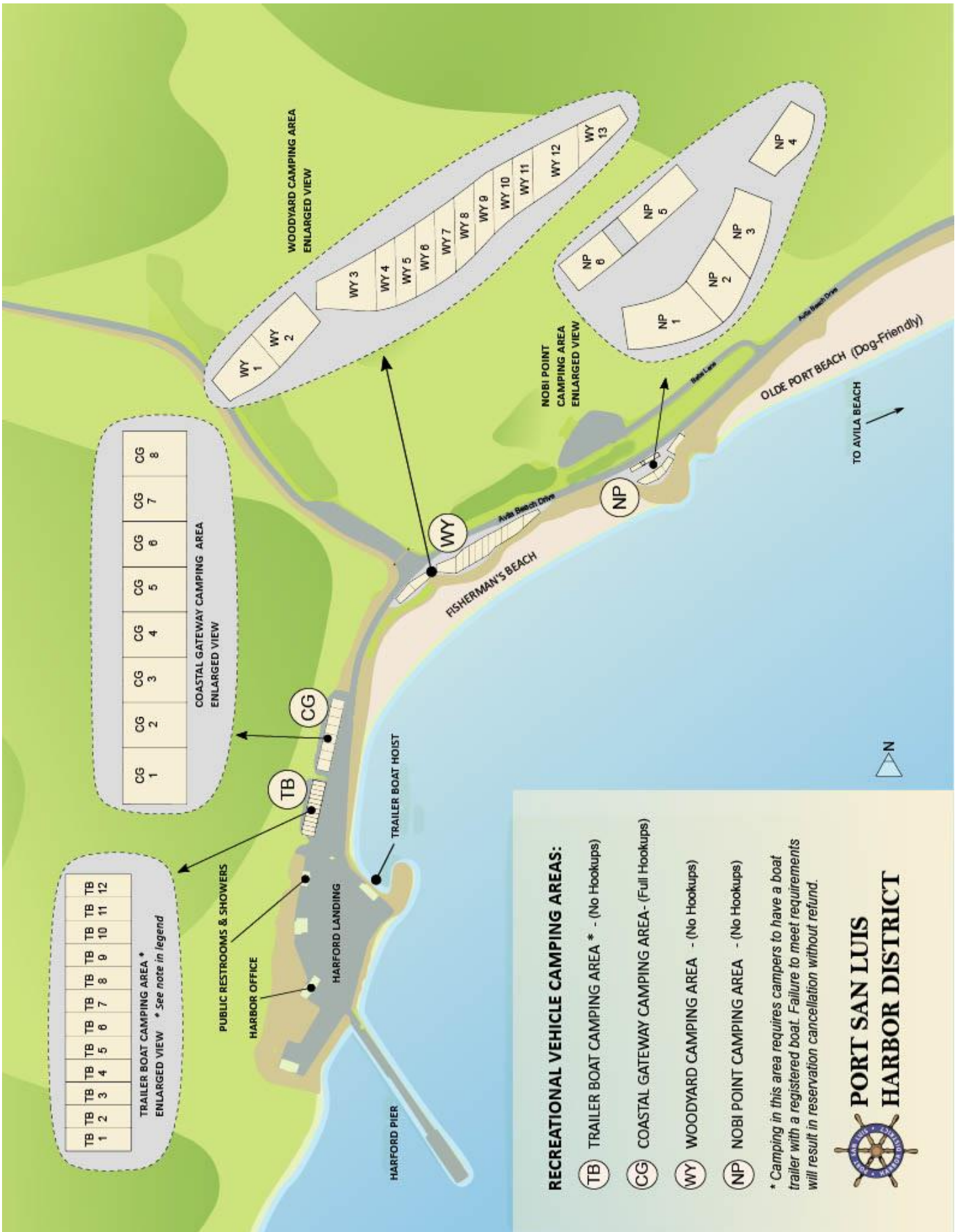

Frequently Asked Questions:

- Q.** Do kayaks qualify for Trailer Boat Camping
A. No. Only boats/recreational vessels that are mechanically propelled qualify for Trailer Boat Camping.
- Q.** Can I use just a Jetski stand and not have trailer?
A. No. Jetski's must have a trailer. Jetski stands are not considered a trailer.
- Q.** Can I reserve two Trailer Boat Camping spots and only have a boat with trailer occupy one of the spots?
A. No. Each Trailer Boat Camping spot must have a boat and trailer in each spot.
- Q.** Can I park a boat/recreational vessel trailer in-between two Trailer Boat Camping spots?
A. No. Each Trailer Boat Camping spot must be occupied with one boat/recreational vessel trailer that was used to tow in the allowed vessel.
- Q.** What will happen if my boat/recreational vessel and/or trailer does not have current/valid registration, or if my boat/recreational vessel does not meet the standards for launching?
A. Your Trailer Boat Camping reservation will be canceled and may not be eligible for refund.

COVID-19

Thank you for your interest in camping here at the Port San Luis Harbor District. To meet the requirements as provided in the California Department of Public Health, please read the information listed below.

If you or someone in your household is exhibiting any COVID-19 symptoms, please cancel your reservation. Please email your cancellation to campingrefunds@portsanluis.com.

Symptoms may appear 2-14 days after exposure to the virus. People with these symptoms may have COVID-19:

- Fever or chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea

Please do your part during your visit:

- a. Maintain 6-foot distance from our Camp Hosts and District Staff.
- b. If unable to maintain a 6-foot distance from our Camp Hosts and District Staff, a face mask must be worn for yours and their protection.
- c. The use of a face covering is required in public spaces when maintaining a physical distance of 6 feet from persons who are not members of the same household or residence is not feasible.
- d. Do not gather in groups and avoid crowded places and mass gatherings.
- e. Do not mix households in your campsite.
- f. When possible, please use your own toilet and shower/bathing equipment, rather than the public facilities.

Additional Information on Face Coverings (Face Masks):

Effective November 16, 2020 an update was issued, and **masks now must be worn anytime you are outside your home.**

People in California must wear face coverings when they are outside of the home

You are exempt from wearing a mask in the following situations:

- Persons in a car alone or solely with members of their own household.
- Persons who are working in an office or in a room alone.
- Persons who are actively eating or drinking provided that they are able to maintain a distance of at least six feet away from persons who are not members of the same household or residence.
- Persons who are outdoors and maintaining at least 6 feet of social distancing from others not in their household. Such persons must have a face covering with them at all times and must put it on if they are within 6 feet of others who are not in their household.
- Persons who are obtaining a service involving the nose or face for which temporary removal of the face covering is necessary to perform the service.
- Workers who are required to wear respiratory protection.
- Persons for whom wearing a face covering would create a risk to the person related to their work, as determined by local, state, or federal regulators or workplace safety guidelines.
- Persons who are specifically exempted from wearing face coverings by other CDPH guidance.

These individuals are exempt from wearing a mask in all settings:

- Persons younger than two years old. These very young children must not wear a face covering because of the risk of suffocation.
- Persons with a medical condition*, mental health condition, or disability that prevents wearing a face covering. This includes persons with a medical condition for whom wearing a face covering could obstruct breathing or who are unconscious, incapacitated, or otherwise unable to remove a face covering without assistance. Such conditions are rare.
- Persons who are hearing impaired, or communicating with a person who is hearing impaired, where the ability to see the mouth is essential for communication.
