Seasonal / Temporary Pay: \$23.35/hr.

Ability to work up to 8 hours per day between 6:30 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. including weekends as needed. 24-40 hours per week. No more than 1,000 hours for the season. No additional benefits except for those required by State and Federal law.

Type of Work: Temporary positions to supplement the District's Utility Crew during the busy summer season. Work is primarily custodial in nature, spending roughly half of the day independently cleaning public restrooms, emptying trash cans, and landscaping grounds. Assist full-time Port Maintenance Workers in performing a variety of general facilities and equipment maintenance tasks.

Contract / Full-Time Pay: \$23.35/hr.

Type of Work: Under supervision, performs a variety of unskilled and semi-skilled tasks in the maintenance and operation of the Port; cleans and maintains buildings and Port property; cleans restrooms and beach areas emptying trash barrels and removing debris from sand and parking areas; acts as part of pier maintenance crew involved in heavy manual labor repair and reconstruction of pier structures; acts as part of crew assigned to repair and maintain buildings, streets, or other land areas; may assist mechanic in fabrication of parts, tools, or in performing mechanical repair functions; and performs other duties as required.

EMPLOYMENT REQUIREMENTS:

KNOWLEDGE OF: Facilities maintenance and janitorial work; general construction, mechanical equipment and hand tools and their proper uses; and safe working practices in a maintenance environment.

ABILITY TO: Follow directions with reading and writing skills to accomplish desired tasks; do heavy manual labor; utilize hand power tools in building and facility maintenance; exercise good judgment in the operation of equipment and in completing jobs independently; and operate various motorized equipment.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS: Valid and current California Driver's License.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS AND WORKING CONDITIONS: Active physical work without prolonged heavy exertion, but with continuous exposure to unpleasant elements such as dust, mud, fumes, odors, dampness, raw or treated sewage, noise levels, or outside weather conditions. On feet most of the time involving bending, stooping, squatting, twisting, reaching, working on irregular surfaces; frequent lifting of objects up to 25 lbs, with occasional lifting of objects weighing over 50 lbs. Must be able to communicate information to other workers via radio.

OTHER REQUIREMENTS: Medical Exam, Drug Test and Background Check.

SELECTION PROCEDURE:

Applications received by the filing date will be reviewed for accuracy, completeness, & job-related qualifications. A limited number of persons whose applications clearly demonstrate they most closely meet the requirements will be invited to participate in the selection process. Appointment is subject to successfully passing an oral interview, written test, background check and medical exam including drug test. Before starting work, applicants must present documentation of their identity, authorization to work in the U.S., a valid California Driver's License.
